J. Loo spoke about the current status of Algoma, the yellow-protect zone that Algoma is currently in. APH is receiving allocations of vaccine this week and next allowing Long Term Care Home residents to receive a second dose. Ongoing regular shipments of the vaccine are expected and vaccinations will continue with highest priority health-care workers next. The plan is to roll-out vaccine as quickly as possible across all regions with the help of hospital and primary care partners. J.Loo answered questions about vaccine hesitancy in the population and spoke about activities such as recent town halls and communications strategies to reach residents and bolster vaccine confidence.
