

• If you develop any symptoms, get tested as soon as

possible and self-isolate until you get your result.





^{*}High-risk settings: Hospitals, paramedics, long-term care, retirement homes, and congregate living settings.

^{**} After 5 days of self-isolation, do NOT attend work until 10 days from your last exposure. Report your exposure to your employer and follow any work restrictions. **Note:** In the context of Omicron, individuals who are previously positive in the last 90 days and not fully vaccinated are not considered equivalent to fully vaccinated.
