## DISINFECTING TIPS

1 Clean and rinse all surfaces with detergent and warm water before you disinfect.
2 Solution must be made fresh daily to preserve strength.
3 Household bleach solution is $5.25 \%$ sodium hypochlorite (bleach) solution.

NOTE: These mixing instructions only apply when 5.25\% bleach is used. Not all bleach products are $\mathbf{5 . 2 5 \%}$ sodium hypochlorite. Refer to the product label to verify the concentration.
