Request for Immunization Information

Under the Immunization of School Pupil's Act (ISPA), all children attending school in Ontario are legally required to be immunized against certain preventable diseases, unless a valid exemption due to medical, conscience, or religious reasons is provided. Algoma Public Health (APH) collects and reviews the immunization records of all students to ensure each child is immunized and their records are up to date.

It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to provide immunization information to APH. Most schools and health care providers do not provide this information directly to us.

Our records show that immunization records for your child are incomplete.

What is missing?

Attached to this letter is the immunization record APH has on file for the above-named student. We require information on the following vaccines:

High school Tdap clinics:

If your child is currently in high school and is overdue for tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap), APH will be offering Tdap clinics in each high school starting in February. Your child will receive a consent form at school. Please fill out this consent form and return it to the school if you wish for your child to receive their Tdap vaccine at the school clinic. If you do not receive a consent form and your child is overdue, please call your local public health office and speak to a Public Health Nurse to fill out the consent form over the phone.

Can my child be exempted from vaccination?

Immunization is one of the safest ways to promote health and prevent illnesses related to vaccine preventable diseases. If you decide not to immunize your child due to medical, conscience, or religious reasons, an exemption form must be sent to APH.

If the immunization information requested is not provided to APH, students may be suspended later this school year as part of the ISPA legislation. APH will provide support to parents, guardians, and students to help them keep their immunization records up to date.
